SCHEDULE

The Victorian Interschool Show Jumping Competition will be run over one day.

Times will be published on the VEC website: www.vechorse.com.au

- All competitors will be eligible for an individual place, whether nominated as an Individual or Team Member.
- Riders will compete in age groups. Please do not enter if you cannot safely jump the maximum height in your class.
- Competition Rules are stated on the inside of back page.
- One performance will count as both Individual and Team score.

DATE

Monday 30th August 2010

Age groups:

Under 8, 8 & under 10, 10 & under 12yrs

12 & under 14year, 14 & under 16yrs and 16&over

ENTRIES

- Competition will commence at 8am.
- Final presentation for team and ages groups will be at the close of competition on Monday 30th August 2010.

COST

- \$60.00 per rider (covers all 3 classes) All costs include GST
- Overnight Yard (12'x12' single rail yards) \$12ea Booking essential

RULES & CONDITIONS

- 1 All Riders must wear ASA approved helmet at all times when mounted.
Team Managers must check each competitor's gear before every class to ensure it is safe.
- 2 Correct attire must be worn in all classes.
School Jumper, Shirt & School tie or Sports Top
Beige, Fawn, Cream, White or Banana Jodhpurs
Short or Long Riding Boots or Leather Gaiters
Pony Club regulation spurs & crops, all other equipment at discretion of Judges & organisers.
- 3 Schools may enter as many teams as they like &/or up to 2 individuals who **must be enrolled** at the same school.
- 4 **Age** applies to actual age on **Day** of competition (**30/08/10**)
- 5 The judge's decision is final. No video evidence is admissible
- 6 No responsibility is accepted for anything that may happen from any cause whatsoever to competitors, spectators, horses or property. It is a condition of entry that each entrant shall agree to indemnify the organisers against any legal action arising from any accident/incident.
- 7 **No dogs** allowed on the property.
- 8 No entry accepted unless signed by nominated adult Team Manager
- 9 Identification numbers must be worn whilst competing
- 10 Competitors must compete on the same mount/s in all classes. No substitution is allowed at any stage. If a rider/mount is not fit for the day, remaining team riders may compete as individuals.
- 11 A mount can only be ridden by one rider in the competition. **Sharing of a mount is not allowed.**
- 12 **No mount under 4 years of age is to be entered** in the competition.
- 13 All protests will incur a \$30 non-refundable deposit All scores will be posted at the completion of a class for a period of 30 minutes before being presented. No protests will be valid after this time.
- 14 No refund of entry fees after closing date, unless Doctor/Vet certificate supplied before start of competition – stating rider/mount unfit
- 15 Classes will be split where numbers are excessive
- 16 Entries will only be accepted on **official entry form**, accompanied by **full payment**. No faxed/emailed, or incomplete entries accepted
- 17 For safety reasons – should a competitor and/or horse fall in the judging arena, they will be eliminated, not allowed to re-mount during that class, & will score no points for that class. Next highest place competitors will be moved up a place accordingly
- 18 If any member of a team does not complete the competition, that Team's scores will not count, but individual scores will qualify
- 19 At no time is a competitor allowed to ride in a competition arena other than to compete in their relevant class. Any competitor found to be doing so will be eliminated and their scores will not count in the overall standings.
- 20 No coaching is allowed from sidelines and no horse can be led into arena.

THE VENUE

The Venue is the Victorian Equestrian Centre in Upper Beaconsfield, which has outstanding facilities – huge indoor arena, two outdoor arenas, seating for 300 and indoor cafeteria overlooking the indoor arena.

Full catering available on the day.

THE TEAMS

Teams to consist of **3 riders** representing the one school, from any of the following age groups. Riders may compete on **up to two** horses. If a rider enters on two mounts, the second mount must be in a different team (or entered as an individual).

THE CLASSES

The competition is made up of **3 Compulsory Classes.**

Jumping Equitation – Judged on the Rider/Mount combination over jumps. The style & position of the rider, placement of mount at jumps & presentation are all taken into consideration.

Max height

Under 8.4m (1ft4in) 8 & under 10.5m (1ft8in) 10 & under 121.6(2ft) 12 & under 14.7(2ft4in) 14 & under 16.8(2ft8in) 16 & over .9 (3ft)

Showjumping – Competitor to learn original course, and shortened Jump-Off course. If a clear round is achieved, Competitor jumps again immediately (on the bell) over Jump-Off course against the clock.

Max height

Under 8.4m (1ft4in) 8 & under 10.5m (1ft8in) 10 & under 121.6(2ft) 12 & under 14.7(2ft4in) 14 & under 16.8(2ft8in) 16 & over .9 (3ft)

Top Score Stakes – Seven jumps scoring points from 40 – 100 plus the Joker (200pts), the only max. height jump – **does not have to be jumped.** Competitor to plan own course to gain maximum points within time allocated, jumping each twice only, from either direction.

Max height

Under 8.4m (1ft4in) 8 & under 10.5m (1ft8in) 10 & under 121.6(2ft) 12 & under 14.7(2ft4in) 14 & under 16.8(2ft8in) 16 & over .9 (3ft)

Each Competitor must compete in all classes to score towards the Individual & Team results.

SCORING SYSTEM

Points will be awarded to Competitors as follows:

1st – 10pts 2nd – 9pts 3rd – 8pts 4th – 7pts 5th – 6pts
6th – 5pts 7th – 4pts 8th – 3pts 9th – 2pts 10th – 1pt

All three Team members' scores to count. If a Team member is forced to scratch from a heat, they may be replaced with an individual entered from the same school, prior to the start of competition.

Each rider's score will be added together over the 3 classes and the team with the highest score will be declared the **Victorian Inter-School Show Jumping Champions** for 2010. Countback will be at the judges/organisers discretion and explained, if applicable on the day.

ENTRIES

Note: Entries will only be accepted on official form with full fees & all details.
